Chablis 2004 - 90 Points

Consumers tend to forget that some Burgundy houses based in Beaune, such as Drouhin, also make outstanding Chablis. They own almost 100 acres, about a quarter of which are in premier and grand cru vineyards, and have a winery in Chablis as well. This wine, their village Chablis, comes partly from their own vineyards and partly from purchased grapes. Vinified and aged entirely in stainless steel tanks, it is a quintessentially flinty, mineral-infused Chablis. Unlike many of the 2003s, it has refreshing citric acidity.

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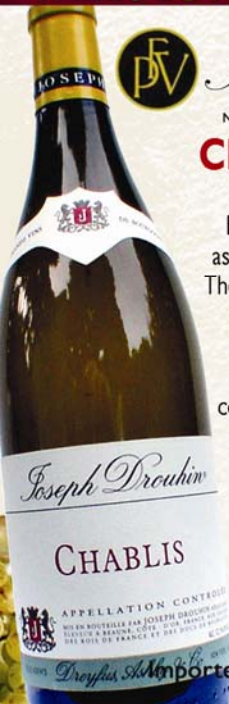
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
